Maria Prime, Vernon Yhap (not in picture) and Daniel Noel are on the

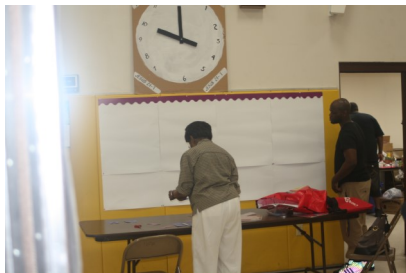
